## Aptitude for wine

### Phenology

**Bud breaking**: late, one week after the Syrah

**Ripening**: second period, similar to the Syrah

### Vigour and production

**Moderately vigorous, upright habit.**

**Yields**: 6-8 t/ha (without irrigation in Mediterranean agroclimatic conditions).
