Aptitude for wine

Phenology

Bud breaking: early to average. Similar to Pinot Blanc in northern region

Ripening: early. One week before the Chardonnay in southern zones; a few days before the Pinot Blanc in northern zones

Vigour and production

Very vigorous

Yields: average to high compared with the Chardonnay.
10 to 16 t/ha in northern region



Resistance to fungal diseases

Powdery mildew	++
Downy mildew	++ / +++

Resistance level : + = moderate resistance ; ++ = good resistance ; +++ = very good resistance



Oenology parameters

High sugar accumulation potential
Intense bouquet, muscat notes, high acidity
