Aptitude for wine

Phenology

Bud breaking: Late, one week after the Syrah

Ripening: Third period, one to two weeks after the Syrah

Vigour and production

Moderately vigorous. Upright habit.

Yields: 10 to 15 t/ha (without irrigation in Mediterranean agroclimatic conditions).

Resistance to fungal diseases

Powdery mildew	total
Downy mildew	+++

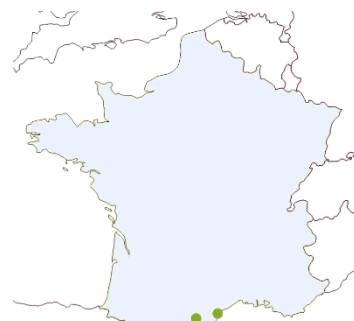
Resistance level : + = moderate resistance ; ++ = good resistance ; +++ = very good resistance

Oenology parameters

Very structured wines, ripe red berry, spicy and balsamic aromas. Adapts very well to the Mediterranean agroclimatic conditions.
