

Identify downy mildew symptoms on resistant grapevine variety leaves

Some varieties are only partially resistant to downy mildew. Symptoms can therefore be visible, mainly on the foliage. They look different from those seen on sensitive varieties and are often accompanied by more or less significant necrosis. The appearance of symptoms can also vary according to the age of the leaves. Here are a few examples on different varieties observed in June.




